My role as co-reviewer, working with the Schizophrenia Group, under the supervision of Prof Clive Adams, Nottingham University, is to examine the evidence of Open Dialogue Approach in psychosis and other severe and enduring mental illness.

I have, under supervision, designed the research, written the research protocol and have applied for the ethical approval and attended the REC panel. The approval has been granted and data collection is in process. The aim is to establish the long-term outcomes of patients assessed under the section 136 of the MHA.
